**The Montmartre District**

This excursion will give you an insight into the history of Montmartre with its major monuments and historical sites. The tour will begin with a coach transfer to the hill followed by a guided walking tour of the Montmartre district and a visit to the Funicular.

Montmartre is a hill (the *butte Montmartre*) which is 130 metres high, giving its name to the surrounding district in the north of Paris, a part of the Right Bank. Montmartre is primarily known for the white-domed Basilica of the Sacré Cœur on its summit and as a nightclub district. The other, older church on the hill is Saint Pierre de Montmartre, which claims to be the location at which the Jesuit order of priests was founded. Many artists had studios or worked around the community of Montmartre: such as Salvador Dalí, Modigliani, Claude Monet, Pablo Picasso and Vincent van Gogh.

During the visit, you'll have the chance to immerse yourself in the atmosphere of Montmartre's different historical periods through evocative places such as the Place du Tertre, the Moulin de la Galette, the vineyards of Montmartre and the Sacré Cœur Basilica.
