**Orsay Museum Guided Visit**

A short walk through the Jardin des Tuileries and across the Seine to the other bank.

The Musée d'Orsay houses world-famous artistic masterpieces from the period 1848-1914. The guided visit provides a general view of the permanent collections: from paintings to fine arts.

Special attention will be given to the Impressionists: Monet, Renoir and their disciples. These artists reinvented not only landscapes but also portraits and scenes from everyday life.

Note: After the guided tour you can stay in the museum until the end of the afternoon to visit other parts and exhibitions.
