The Heart of Provence

Day 1: AVIGNON, St. REMY de PROVENCE

Arrival by your own itinerary in Avignon TGV station (or Marseille Airport) – Transfer to Avignon centre by coach. After a lunch and a short Avignon city walking tour (including the Papal Palace) you will be transferred to a rental car or bike station to pick up your vehicle. You will then travel through St Remy de Provence (30 miles), a beautiful village located in the heart of the Alpilles mountains. Dinner and accommodations.

Day 2: St REMY de PROVENCE, GORDES

Travel the road to "Les Baux de Provence" for a private tour and visit of an Olive Oil Mill then proceed to Les Baux village for a guided tour and some leisure time to stroll in the small streets – Fantastic view on the Alpilles mountains and the Camargue plains! After lunch, you will enjoy an afternoon trip that will bring you to Gordes (110 miles), one of the "most beautiful villages of France" on a very scenic road (with a surprise tasting) - Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 3: GORDES, MONT VENTOUX

A very impressive day on scenic roads: Start with Vaison La Romaine (antique Roman town), then you will climb Mt Ventoux, called Provence's giant, in a very protected and wonderful forest. A stop in Sault village, a lavender growing area, with a tasting visit at a "Nougat" factory and a typical lunch. Then for your afternoon, your route will pass around Mt Ventoux through very scenic areas before returning to Gordes for your second night at the same hotel (175 miles).

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France to Discover

One of the oldest nations in Europe, France - which the Romans called Gaul - is also a country with a very rich cultural and environmental heritage. The climate in France is quite varied, but generally west European - on the whole a bit warmer than the UK, a bit cooler than Spain. Don't expect to find summer in winter in the South of France!

While travelling through historical cities and quaint towns of France a tourist will experience authentic French treasures such as castles, towers, cathedrals, rural buildings, vineyards, mountains and beaches...just to name a few.

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Day 4: GORDES, FORCALQUIER, ARLES, AVIGNON

An epicurean delight for you today ! A lovely road that brings you to Haute Provence, a region between the Lure and the Luberon mountains. You will discover the famous "pastis drink" followed by a typical meal in Forcalquier. Then, head back to Alpilles and Camargue to return the bikes and cars at the rental stations. Transfer in deluxe coach to Avignon, the Côtes du Rhône wine Capital. A wonderful farewell dinner and overnight stay in Avignon.

Day 5: DEPARTURE

A full breakfast then transfer to the TGV station (or to the Marseille Airport).
