Tivoli and its Villas

Crossing the Ponte Lucano, be sure to admire the Tomb of Plautius Lucanus before arriving for a visit of Villa Adriana (Hadrian's Villa) built under the orders of the homonymous Roman emperor. The tour will continue sightseeing with a visit of Villa D'Este, famous for its water system, the architecture of its gardens, the pavilions, the artificial caves, and the fountains.
