On this part of the tour you will enjoy a spectacular ride up Table Mountain by cable car (weather permitting) for a scenic view of Cape Town. You will explore the city centre with visits to the Castle of Good Hope, South African Museum, The Company Gardens, Bo-Kaap - Traditional Malay Quarter and South Africa's most visited attraction, Victoria & Alfred Waterfront.

Note: If the Table Mountain cable car (funicular) is not running due to bad weather, we will drive you up to the spectacular Signal Hill view site above Cape Town as an alternative.
