Built on a site where an open-air market has existed since the 13th century, just off of La Rambla street, the world-famous Boqueria is surely Barcelona's greatest food market. You will enjoy an incredible contrast between colours and activity, ideal discovering why Mediterranean cuisine is internationally known due to its ingredients.

The tour will continue to the Gothic Quarter where you will discover architecture, atmosphere, language and gastronomy that are unique to Spain. En route to the Gothic quarter the tour will stop at a buzzing Mediterranean Brassiere with an excellent selection of tapas. Three tasty montaditos (tapas) and a glass of wine or beer will be waiting for you.
