Pontevedra offers an extremely beautiful old quarter. Highlights include Cinco Ruas Square, Sta. María a Mayor Basilica, Do Peirao Square, Do Burgo Bridge, De Pedreira Square, and more. We also recommend visiting nearby towns such as Crove, San Xenso, la Toja and Combarro, with their ancient hórreos (raised graneries), as well as Pontevedra itself, with its old quarter.

**Day 5: Pontevedra, Cambados**

This is the land where the Albariño wine is produced. In Cambados you can explore Pazo de Fefiñanes country house and San Benito Church, or the ruins of Sta. Mariña. The former Pazo de Bazán country house, an ancestral mansion on which construction began in the 17th c., is located in the green landscape of the Rías Baixas, specifically in the Ría de Arousa. Luxuriant groves, beaches, coves and numerous country houses run along the Galician coast. The Parador is located in the centre of the small town of Cambados, a short distance from the Isla de la Toxa, and has an attractive inner courtyard in which the arcades, the fountain and a slender palm tree stand out.

**Day 6: Cambados, Santiago**

A mixture of history, art and tradition, the dream of pilgrims and an emblem of Santiago, the 'Hostal Reyes Católicos' is located in the Plaza do Obradoiro which forms a magnificent golden corner with the cathedral, imparting beauty on one of the most visited regional capitals of the world. The 'Hostal', which originated as a Royal Hospital in 1499 to give refuge to the numerous pilgrims making their way to Santiago, today continues to invite the traveller to enjoy a universal and fascinating city. Considered to be the oldest hotel in the world, it is also one of the most luxurious and beautiful. Santiago is a World Heritage City, and offers travelers any number of sites to visit. Sites to be noted are Obradoiro Square with its beautiful cathedral, the university's square, the ruas along which you can stroll and experience the life of the city's inhabitants, palaces, churches and museums such as the cathedral museum
